the only difference being that the wing is rectangular instead of circular.

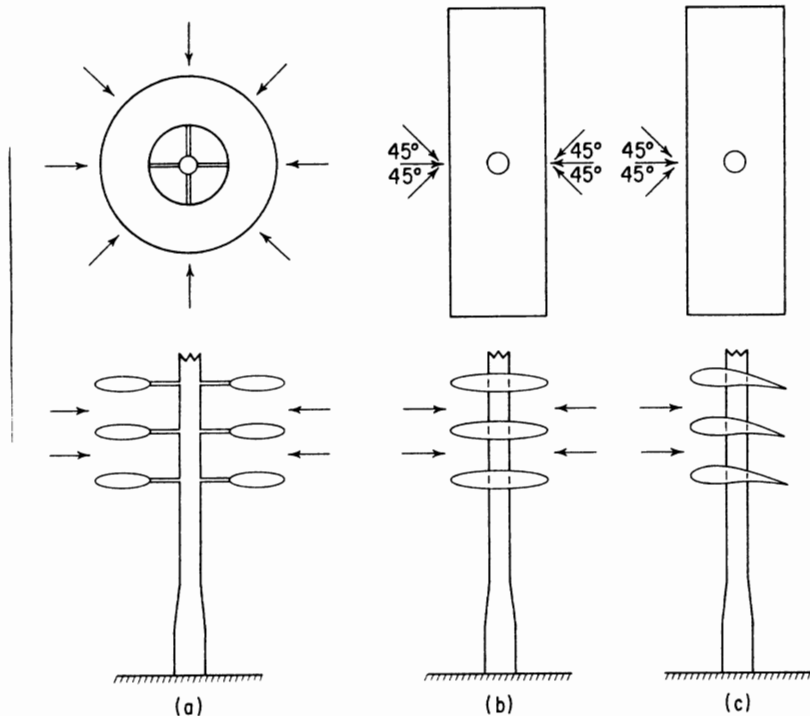


Fig. 35. Three versions of the wing aerogenerator: (a) The circular neutral wing aerogenerator. (b) The linear neutral wing aerogenerator. (c) The linear lift wing aerogenerator. The aspirator holes in the wings are not shown.
